## Special Awards

The **Sunderland Co-operative Trophy** is awarded to the soloist in the school-trained vocal classes for both girls or boys, ages 11 and 12 who, in the judgment of the adjudicator shows the greatest potential for further study.

▶ The **Don McCaskell Memorial Scholarships** are presented to pianists in Grades, 6, 7 and 8 to "encourage continued study".

▶ The **Baldwin Sales Duet Award** is presented to woodwind duet participants (trained or untrained) who, in the judgment of the adjudicator, show the greatest potential for further study.
